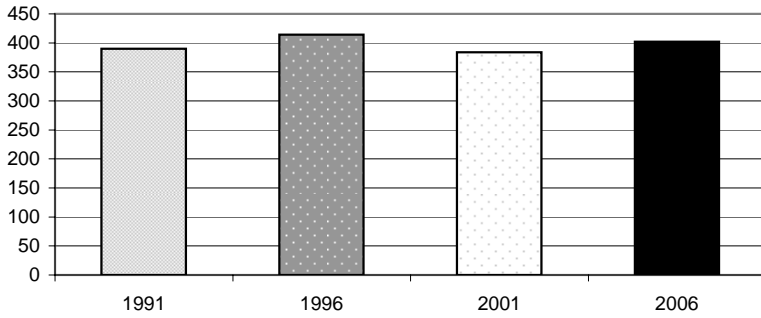

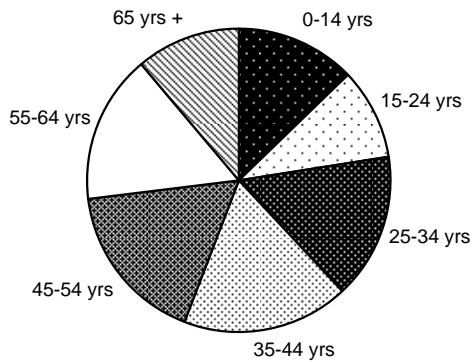
## Usually Resident Population

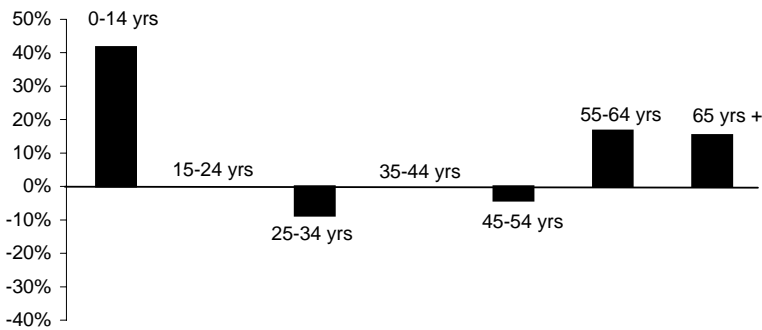

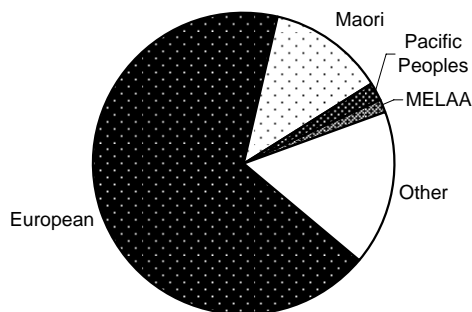

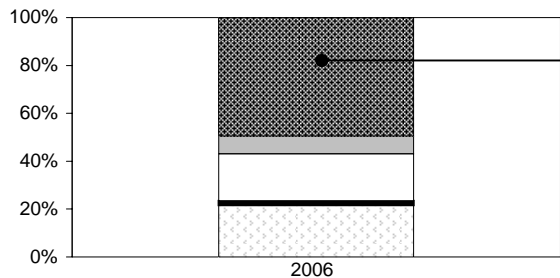

### Employment Status: 15 Years and Over



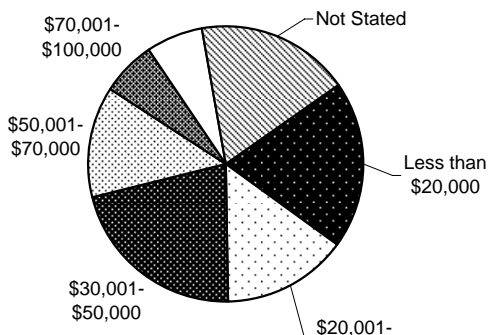

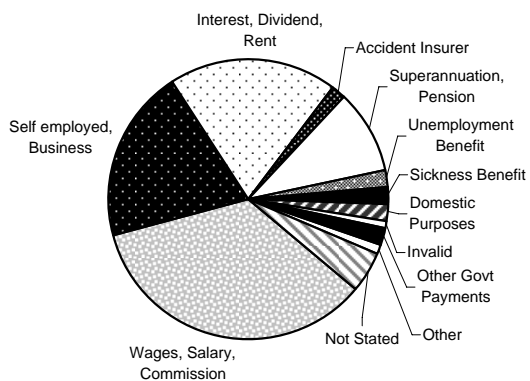
