Appendix 1: Hours for a typical hotel or tavern with a "24 hour" licence

- (a) In respect of the On Licence:
- (i) At any time on any day for consumption on the premises to any person who is for the time being living on the premises, whether as a lodger, or an employee of the licensee, or otherwise; or
 - (ii) At any time on any day for consumption on the premises to any person who is present on the premises for the purpose of dining; or
 - (iii) At any time on any day for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises, excluding Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day and ANZAC Day before 1.00 pm.

- (b) In respect of the Off Licence:
- (i) From the bottle store: On any day to any person who is present on the premises from 7.00 am to 11.00 pm.
 - (ii) Across the bar: At any time on any day, to any person who is present on the premises.

Providing that liquor will not be sold on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day and before 1.00 pm on ANZAC Day.

- (c) In respect of the Off (Caterers) Licence:
At any time on any day to person attending any reception, function or other social gathering promoted by any person or association of persons other than the holder of this licence.
